Cards for Correct and Incorrect Components of Evidence-based Focused ANC

Monitoring blood pressure and signs and symptoms of pre-eclampsia/ eclampsia

VCT for HIV for women at risk only Tetanus toxoid immunization

Risk screening at every ANC visit

Detection of preexisting conditions which may complicate pregnancy

Determination of fetal position prior to 36 weeks gestation **Frequent visits**

(at least monthly) for all pregnant women

Clinical pelvimetry to assess adequacy for delivery

"Opt out" counseling and testing for HIV and education and clinical services for the prevention of maternal to child transmission (PMTCT) including use of condoms during pregnancy in discordant couples

Confirmation of fetal position by 36 weeks of pregnancy Examination for ankle edema

Prevention and

treatment of anemia

- Iron/folate supplementation for at least 6 months of pregnancy and 2 months postpartum
- De-worming medication in areas where parasites are common

Urinalysis for proteinuria in third trimester if signs of pre-eclampsia

Promotion of active management of the third stage of labor for the prevention of postpartum hemorrhage

Recognition and treatment of sexually transmitted infections (STIs)

Measurement of weight/BMI and assessment of nutritional status **Prevention of malaria** in pregnancy **Intermittent preventive** treatment (IPT) for malaria – Insecticide treated bednets (ITNs)

Cards for Correct and Incorrect Warning Signs of Complications in Pregnancy or Postpartum

Nausea in first trimester

Diminished/ loss of fetal movement Pale conjunctiva, tongue, palms and nail beds

Persistent lower abdominal pain Increased fetal ovement

Rupture of membranes or foul smelling discharge

Contractions at term (near due date)

Severe headache, blurred vision, seizures, loss of consciousness

Ankle edema

Swelling of hands and face

Jaundice

Fever

Persistent vomiting

Mild fatigue after birth

Urinary frequency in pregnancy (without burning or blood in urine)

Bleeding from the vagina

Mild vaginal bleeding in first postpartum week
