



Terms of reference (TOR) for IPC Focal Point

Under the supervision of the MOH/WHO IPC team, the IPC Focal Point conducts the following activities:

- ✓ Ensures correct IPC practices and staff safety implemented effectively in the assigned health facilities.
- ✓ Serves as the focal point for all partners in terms of IPC and occupational health
- ✓ Provides training on IPC and occupational health in coordination with relevant partners
- ✓ Assesses IPC capacities and practices in the assigned health facilities and report to MOH/WHO IPC team.
- ✓ Identifies needs for IPC resources and supplies including PPE and further trainings based on the assessment.
- ✓ Immediately reports to the MOH/WHO IPC team if a staff member has ebola-like syndrome or an incident occurs. Incidents include staff percutaneous or mucocutaneous exposure to blood/body fluids from a patient.
