

Infection Prevention and Control: Check list for Health Care Facilities and Ebola Care Centers

- 1. Daily checks of all staff temperatures in place
- 2. Hand hygiene solutions (soap/water, chlorine, hand sanitizer) are widely available for both staff and patients.
- 3. Enough stock of PPEs (Gloves, gowns, hoods, boots, shields (or goggles), masks, apron) is available.
- 4. Staff wear and remove PPE properly.
- 5. Chlorine solution (0.5%, 0.05%) is properly prepared/used.
- 6. Holding space/ward is functioning; clean, not overcrowded.
- 7. All surfaces in patient care areas are cleaned at least daily and on discharge (beds, bed rails, and bedside tables). Floors/Toilets are cleaned every day.
- 8. Waste is properly managed.
