

MDR-TB Patient Education Flipchart



This tool can be used to educate new patients about TB and MDR-TB. The healthcare provider should review the material together with the patient. A treatment supporter can also use this flipchart at community level to reinforce the concepts covered.

Major concepts covered in the flipchart:

- TB is a contagious disease, which means it can be spread from person to person.
- TB generally lives in the lungs, but it can also infect other parts of the body.
- If TB is left untreated, it can kill the patient.
- TB can be cured with the right medicine.

The flipchart can be adapted and modified as needed. The Mongolian Anti-Tuberculosis Association has adapted the flipchart for use in physician counseling training and in training of community health workers providing home-based care.
