The numbers behind the Red Cross work

Seven people make up one burial team, on average. Each person undergoes **120 hours** of training.

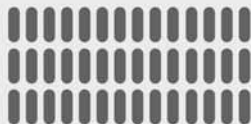


Teams can spend **8 hours** traveling from one burial to another.

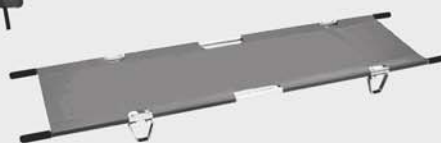
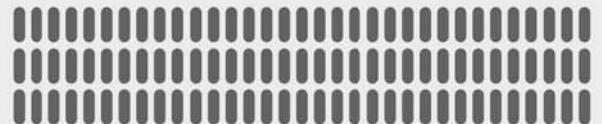


One body bag costs **\$65 US dollars**

Burial teams use an average of **40 body bags per week** in West Africa.



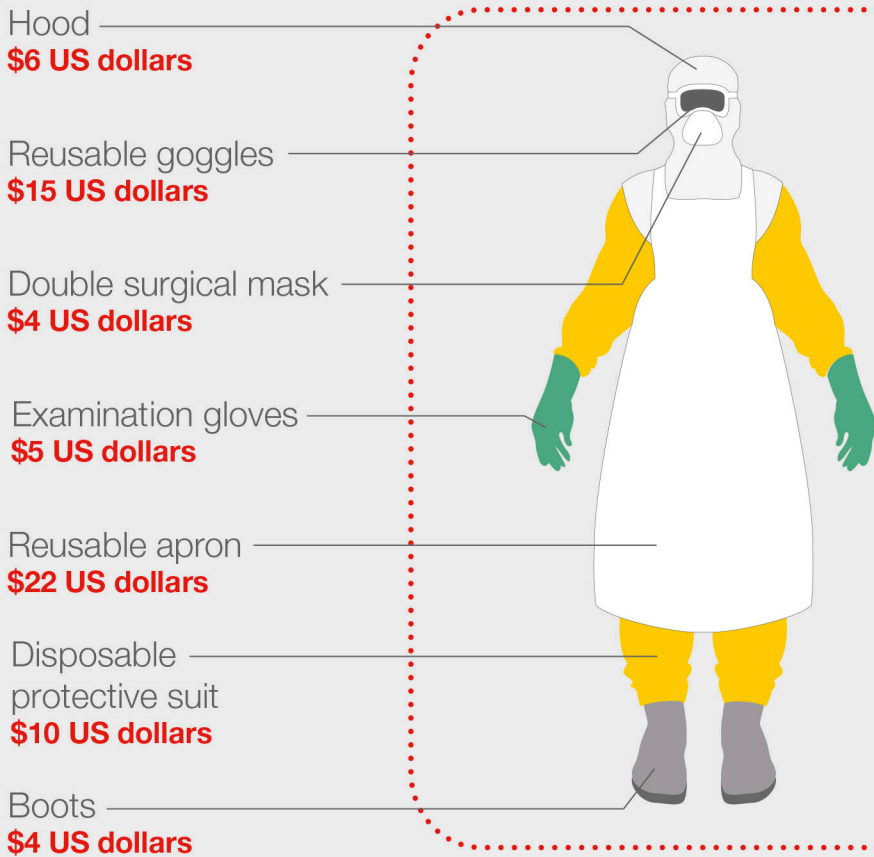
In Liberia, one burial team uses at least **100 body bags per week**.



One complete burial kit costs **\$3,700 US dollars**. Each kit contains personal protective equipment, stretcher, body bags and disinfecting supplies.

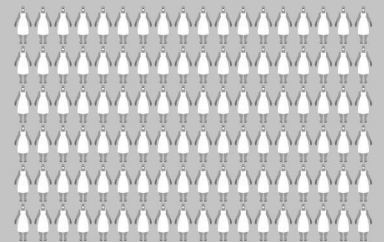
CLINICAL CASE MANAGEMENT

The cost of Ebola treatment



One complete set of personal protective equipment (PPE), costs **\$66 US dollars**.
Most of the equipment is used just once.

The Red Cross Ebola Treatment Centre in Sierra Leone uses **150 – 180 sets** of PPE **every day**



That's 5,000+ and \$330,000 US dollars per month.

A health care worker in the centre will suit up **four times over an 8-hour shift**. While wearing the PPE, they will:



- ⚠ Work a maximum of **1 hour** to reduce the risk of heat stroke
- ⚠ Be exposed to temperatures of up to **47 degree Celsius** (116 degrees Fahrenheit).
- ⚠ Produce up to **3 litres/0.8 gallons** of sweat per hour.

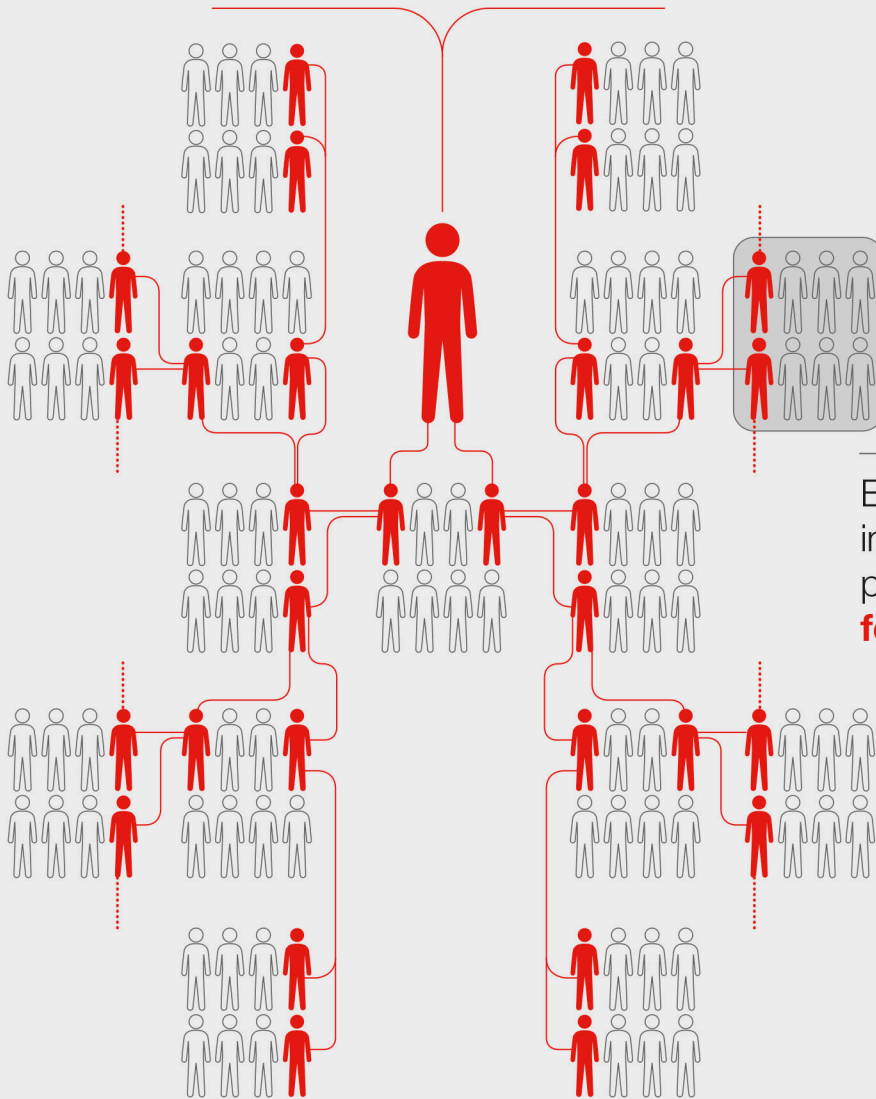

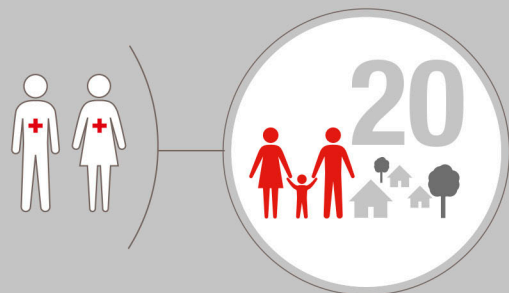
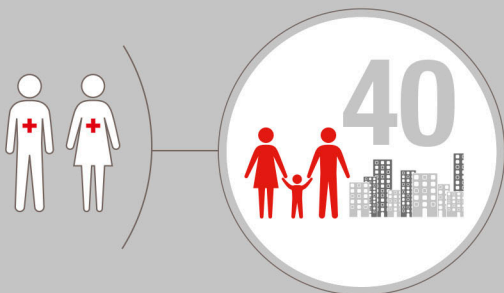
CONTACT TRACING

In urban areas, 2 people can trace up to **40 households** a day.
In rural areas, 2 people can trace up to **20 households** a day.

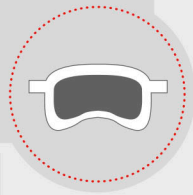

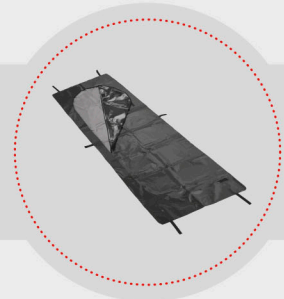

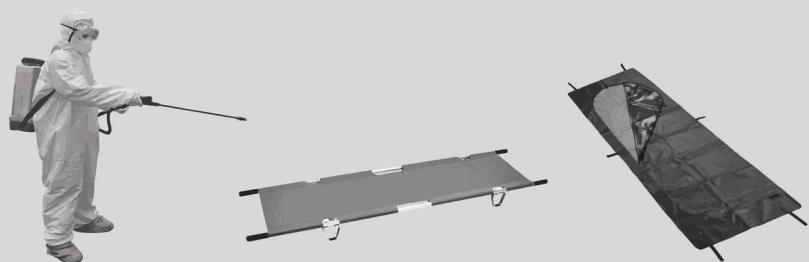
US dollars can buy one complete set personal of protective equipment
