

PRECAUTIONS FOR STORM/ CYCLONE



Do not venture into the river.



Keep the valuables in the safe place.



Insure house and household articles.



Move cattle to a safe place with ample fodder and drinking water.



WHAT THE PEOPLE SHOULD DO.
Listen to the radio for latest news/
warning on cyclone.



Store dry food, drinking water and fuel at a safe place when there is a warning.



IF STORM OR CYCLONE HITS
YOUR PLACE.

Store or secure loose boards, corrugated iron, unused tins or anything else that could become dangerous.



Strong winds can break windows and doors, so keep them secured.



Move to the nearest cyclone shelter or any other safer place if so advised by any Government agency.



Don't move outside during cyclone.
