


Infectious



- Gauze/dressings
- Gloves
- Anatomical waste (foreskin)
- Blood
- IV fluid lines
- Plastic forceps
- O-drape Plastic container tray
- Plastic apron
- Alcohol swab
- Test strip

STEP 3. FINAL **DISPOSAL**/ DESTRUCTION

- Dispose of via dedicated infectious waste pit
- Incinerate
- Treat via approved alternative technology

Health Care Waste Streams

Sharps



- Syringes with needles (no denotching)
- Infusion sets
- Scalpels
- Blades
- Broken glass
- Sutures
- Lancet



- Dispose of via dedicated sharps pit
- Incinerate
- Treat via approved alternative technology

General




- Packaging materials (uncontaminated)
- Office supplies
- Beverage containers
- Hand towels
- Boxes
- Glass/plastic bottles
- Food

- Cardboard
- Plastic/cellophane wrap
- Cling wrap
- Food wrap



- Separate components to be sent for recycling
- Dispose of remaining waste in general landfill site
- Incinerate

Pharmaceutical



- Damaged/unusable pharmaceuticals
- Expired pharmaceuticals •



- Destroy in specialized incinerator
- Inertize and place in specialized waste landfill
- Encapsulate
