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Training

Training is an essential element in ACAPS' work towards strengthening the capacity of the humanitarian sector to carry out multi-sectoral assessments.

Over the last 5 years, ACAPS has developed and delivered training in coordinated assessments for a range of partners including UN agencies, NGOs and other humanitarian actors.

In order to expand the reach of its training activities, ACAPS is now providing free e-learning modules in assessment basics.

E-learning

In cooperation with Geneva Centre for Education and Research in Humanitarian Action, University of Geneva, ACAPS has developed an online training course, which covers the basics of coordinated needs assessment in emergencies. The course is divided into six chapters. ACAPS is grateful to CARE International for their financial contribution to the development of these modules.

This is the first module in a series of e-learning courses on needs assessment. Further modules are under development.
