


Pregnant Women Residing in an Area with Ongoing Zika Virus Transmission



¹Clinical illness consistent with Zika virus disease includes two or more of the following signs or symptoms: acute onset of fever, maculopapular rash, arthralgia, or conjunctivitis.

²Local health officials should determine when to implement testing of asymptomatic pregnant women based on information about levels of Zika virus transmission and laboratory capacity.
