The People Living with HIV Stigma Index

The stigma index among people living with HIV is **18.1%**. The index represents the level of perceived stigma and discrimination experienced among people living with HIV

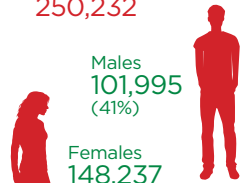

Estimated Number of People Living with HIV (PLHIV)



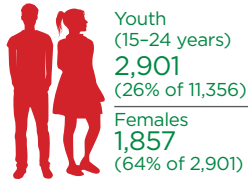

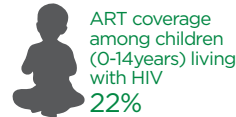
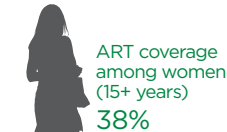

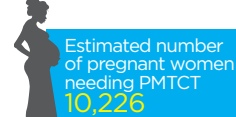
Estimated Antiretroviral Therapy (ART) Coverage



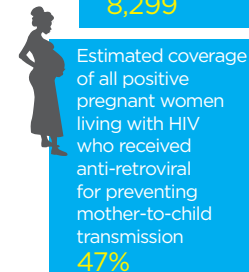
ART coverage among adults (15+ years)

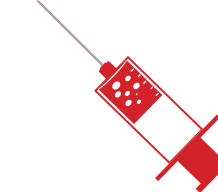
