**Trends in Total Fertility Rate** 

### Fertility

Women in Sierra Leone have an average of 4.9 children, a slight decrease from 5.1 in 2008.Women in rural areas have 2.2 more children than women in urban areas.

## Family Planning

Modern contraceptive use among married women has doubled since 2008 from 7% to 16% in 2013.

### **Trends in Modern Contraceptive Use**

## **Child Mortality**

For the 15-year period before the survey, child mortality ratesneonatal, infant, and under-5have decreased.



### **Vaccination Coverage**

Vaccination coverage has increased in Sierra Leone. Sixty-eight percent of children age 12-23 months are fully vaccinated, compared with 40% in 2008.
