

PREFACE

The 19th National Medicines Committee (NMC) meeting was held on 12-13 May, 2016 for revision of National Essential Medicines List (NEML). There have been 27 new additions, 14 deletions, 11 extensions and 3 changes in the specifications. The 2016 edition has been brought out incorporating all the afore mentioned changes and segregating the medicines into their respective categories.

In this edition, medicines used in ICU, haemodialysis and chemotherapy unit has also been added under NEML. The medicines under disinfectants and antiseptics, intrauterine devices and barrier methods under contraceptives has been deleted and moved to medical supplies and equipment list. A section on traditional essential medicines list is also included at the end of the NEML.

There are now a total of 429 medicines in the National Essential Medicines List 2016.

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CONCEPT OF ESSENTIAL MEDICINES

Essential medicines, as defined by the World Health Organization (WHO) are "*those medicines that satisfy the health care needs of the majority of the population; they should therefore be available at all times in adequate amounts and in appropriate dosage forms, at a price the community can afford*". The **National Essential Medicines List (NEML)** has been compiled and developed by a committee of doctors, pharmacists and other relevant health professionals, called the **National Medicines Committee (NMC)** which meets at least once every two years to review the list and to discuss other technical matters related to the pharmaceuticals. The selection of essential medicines is based on the following criteria as per the National Medicine Policy:

- Therapeutic need;
- Relevance to national morbidity patterns;
- Efficacy and safety;
- Cost effectiveness;
- Ease and safety in dispensing and administration;
- Usefulness in more than one condition;
- Likelihood of patient compliance;
- Training and experience of the prescribers; and
- The treatment facilities available in the country.

These criterions mean that a well-established medicine will be chosen rather than a newly developed one (on grounds of proven efficacy and safety); oral medication will be preferred to injections (which are more dangerous to administer); tablets will be preferred to liquid preparations; and medicines with low margins of safety will be restricted to specialist prescribers only.
