The 2016 Ghana Malaria Indicator Survey (GMIS) provides population-based estimates on malaria indicators to inform strategic planning and programme evaluation. The 2016 GMIS is the 1st Malaria Indicator Survey conducted in Ghana.

MALARIA PREVALENCE



Malaria Prevalence by Region

21% of children age 6-59 months tested positive for malaria by microscopy.

Malaria prevalence ranges from a low of 5% in Greater Accra to a high of 31% in Eastern.

MALARIA PREVENTION



52% of children under 5 and50% of pregnant women sleptunder an LLIN the night beforethe survey.



60% of pregnant women received3+ doses of SP/Fansidar to prevent malaria in pregnancy.
