Error 4 Correction 1: Page 165, Key Findings 2nd bullet

- **Symptoms of ARI:** Advice or treatment was sought for ~~84~~ 80% of children under age 5 who had symptoms of an acute respiratory infection (ARI) in the 2 weeks before the survey. Thirty-nine percent had treatment or advice sought on the same or next day.

Error 4 Correction 2: Page 168, 2nd paragraph under section 10.3

Advice or treatment was sought for 8 in 10 (~~84~~ 80%) children under age 5 with ARI symptoms in the 2 weeks before the survey; however, but was sought for only 4 in 10 (39%) on the same or next day.

Error 5: 146 children who had taken antimalarial drugs were initially excluded from the denominator.

Error 5 Correction 1: Page 225, Key Findings 5th bullet

- **Artemisinin-based combination therapy:** Among children under age 5 with a fever in the 2 weeks preceding the survey who took any antimalarial medication, ~~92~~ 88% received artemisinin-based combination therapy (ACT).

Error 5 Correction 2: Page 230, 2nd paragraph under section 12.5

Among children with a fever in the 2 weeks preceding the survey who took any antimalarial medication, ~~92~~ 88% received artemisinin-based combination therapy (ACT). The next most used drug was quinine pills/syrup, taken by ~~8~~ 7% of children (**Table 12.12**).

Error 5 Correction 3: Page 230, last sentence in Trends paragraph under section 12.5:

The use of ACT for treatment of fever among children has increased considerably, from 5% in 2006 to 39% in 2009, 69% in 2011, 87% in 2014-15, and ~~92~~ 88% in 2016 (**Figure 12.7**).

Error 5 Correction 4: Page 230, Figure 12.7

The percentage of children who received ACTs in 2016 should change from 92% to 88%.
