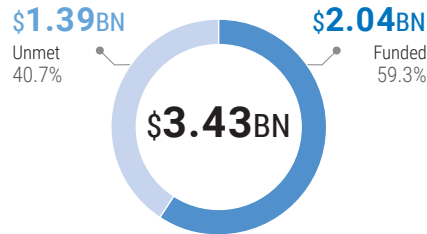

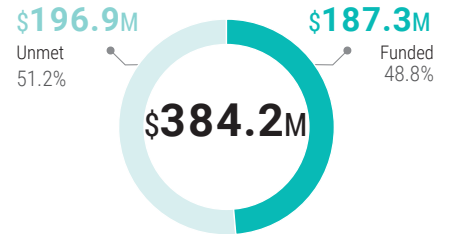

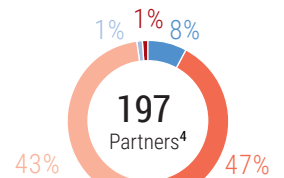

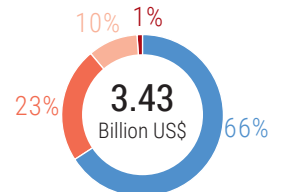

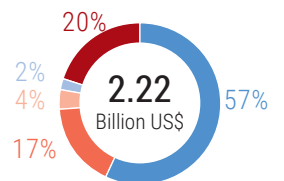
NUMBER OF HRP PARTNERS
