


Cyclone Kenneth - Situation Overview

LIVELIHOODS:

APS, Istituto OIKOS, Oxfam with ADEL-CD are supporting around 4,650 households with vegetable seeds distribution;

FAO plans to support 10,000 fishermen with: fishing boats (new and repair), fishing nets, engines and trainings/capacity development activities.

FOOD:

Total number of people reached by FSC partners as of 8 June: 532 190 (56 626 with emergency food & 496 730 with food rations - rice, oil and pulse);


Food rations distributed by the following FSC partners: 39% Government of Mozambique, 46% WFP and its partners (Caritas, CCM, SEPPA, OIKOS), 11% IRIS, 2% Nema Foundation, 1% ADRA and private sectors.

KEY ISSUES

- Some areas remain hard to reach due to access and security issues;
- Regular Food Rations will progressively replace the emergency food rations;
- Livelihoods activities to support agriculture and fisheries are increasing;
- Early recovery activities remain severely underfunded.
