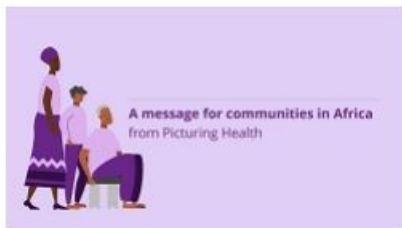
COVID on the Breadline
