# MAY HIGHLIGHTS

## NUTRITION:

- Delivering BSFP services for 115,629 children U2 & PLW through 236 food distribution points in seven districts of Ibb and Taizz governorates.
- A total of 105 children U5 and 207 pregnant and lactating women received TSP services through six health facilities in Taizz governorate.

## FOOD SECURITY & LIVELIHOOD:

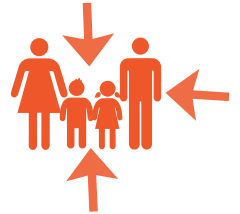

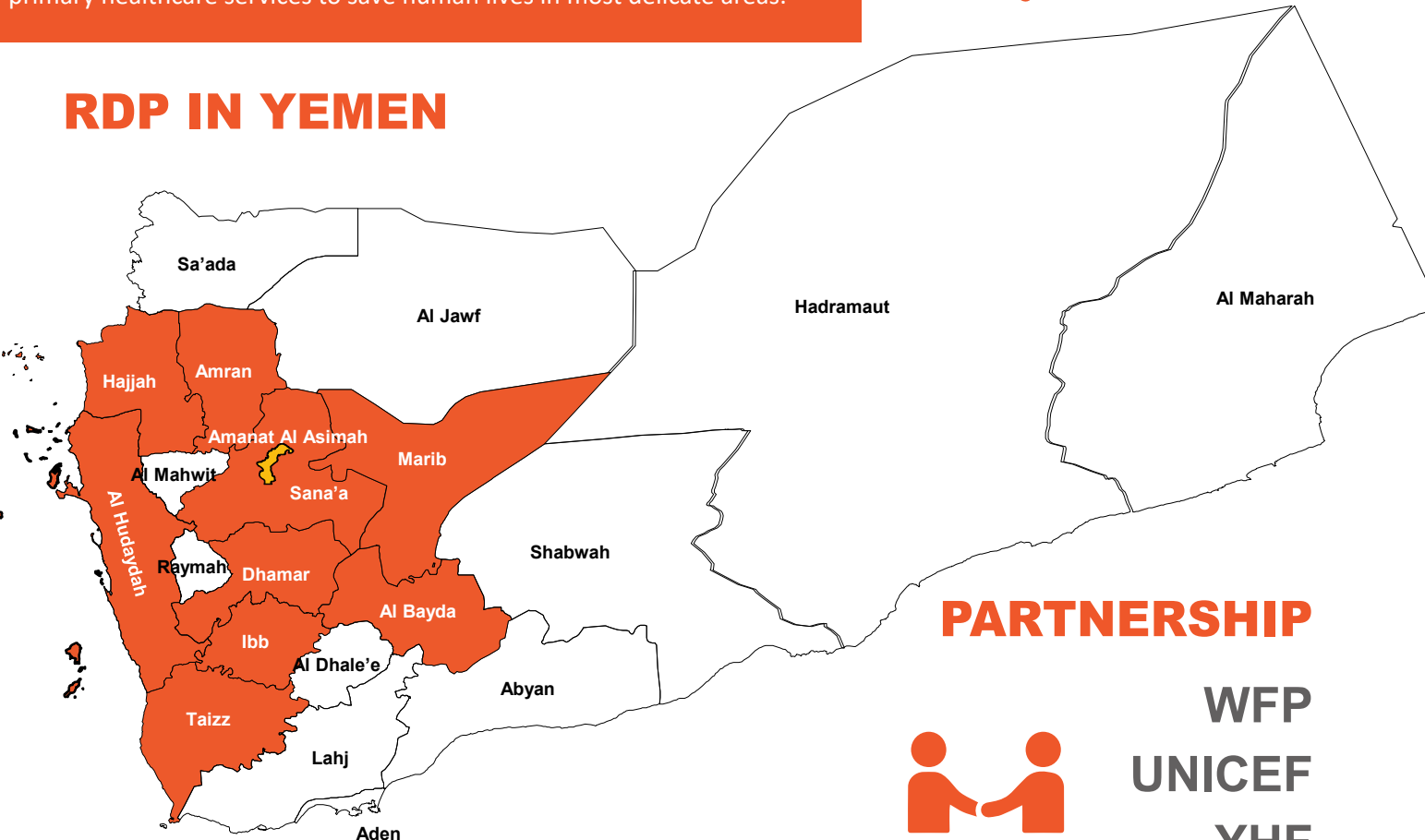

## To survive the onslaught of COVID-19, RDP-supported CHVs have launched dozens of awareness-raising campaigns to benefit a total of 11,909 individuals

In response to the fatal pandemic of COVID-19, RDP funded by Sign of Hope e.V began the implementation of COVID-19 infection & prevention activities project, targeting six districts of Ibb and Taizz governorates. Its major objective is to reduce the spread of coronavirus pandemic by intensifying the precautionary and preventive activities that contribute to raising awareness of the public

and providing them with hygiene, sterilization and necessary medical care. Accordingly, 115 community health volunteers were successfully trained on COVID-19 related information, and then started launching dozens of awareness-raising campaigns to benefit a total of 11,909 individuals in six districts (Far Al-Udayn, Al-Udayn, Hazm Al-Udayn, Mudhaikhera, Same and As Silw - of Ibb and Taizz Governorates.

## In light of this fatal pandemic, RDP ensures the continuity of delivering primary healthcare services to save human lives in most delicate areas

Through the Emergency MSP Project funded by YHF, RDP health workers in (Al-Shejab, Khaleelah and Makhlaq) health facilities have served 26 reproductive health cases (26 ANC, 0 ND, 0 PNC), vaccinated 7 children and provided medical consultations to 544 individuals (121 men, 156 women, 136 boys, 131 girls) in Al Abdiyah district of Marib Gov. Additionally, 374 individuals were benefitted from the awareness sessions conducted by our CHVs on health key messages.

## Delivering BSFP services for 115,629 children U2 & PLW through 236 food distribution points in seven districts of Ibb and Taizz governorates

During May, a total number of 55,692 children under 2 received 80 MTs of Plumpy Doz while an achieved total number of 59,937 PLW were provided with 345 MTs of WSB+ (soya) through 236 food distribution points (FDPs) and 708 community nutrition volunteers in 7 districts - Far Al-Udayn, Al-Udayn, Hazm Al-Udayn, Mudhaikhera, Al Qafr, Same and As Silw - of Ibb and Taizz Governorates. In addition, the CNVs have educated a total of 34,447 individuals disaggregated (3,629 men, 8,084 pregnant women, 10,532 lactating women, 12,202 other women) through awareness raising campaigns in the targeted districts.



## A total of 105 children U5 and 207 pregnant and lactating women received TSFP services through six health facilities in Taizz governorate

RDP continues to deliver nutritional supplements for moderately acutely malnourished children and pregnant and lactating women through six supported health facilities in Sama and As Silw districts of Taizz Governorate. During May, a number of 105 CU5 and 207 PLW were served with nutritional commodities (Plumpy sup and WSB+). Besides, our CNVs reached a number of 279 individuals disaggregated (203 women, 47 boys, 29 girls) through awareness-raising campaigns in the targeted districts.







## RDP reaches 53,928 individuals and provides them with food rations in Wald Rabi, Al Malagim, and As Sawadiya districts of Al-Bayda Governorate

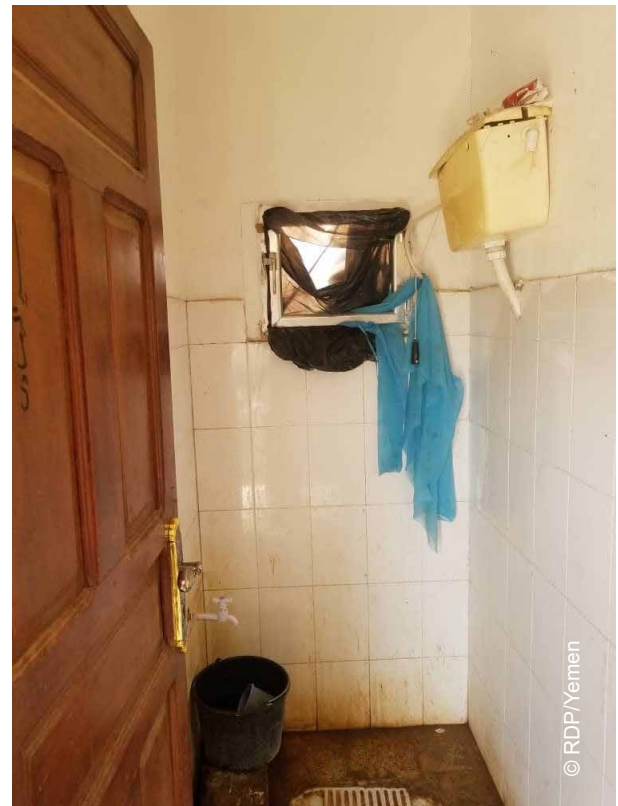
Even though COVID-19 has caused major restrictions for vulnerable communities and tougher challenges for aid workers, RDP continues to distribute food baskets within the General Food Assistance (GFA) project funded by WFP to benefit a total number of 53,410 individuals disaggregated (21,364 men, 22,219 women, 4,806 boys, 5,021 girls) in 3 districts (Wald Rabi, Al Malagim, and As Sawadiya) of Al-Bayda Governorate. 7,630 HHs have received their food baskets which consist of 75 KGs of wheat flour, 5 KGs of beans, 8 liters of vegetable oil, 2.5 KGs of sugar, 0.5 Kg. of salt. In addition, RDP has distributed food baskets to the IDPs group in which 518 individuals were benefitted in the three targeted districts.





## In six governorates, 186 healthcare facilities have been thoroughly assessed in terms of damage, water supplies, sanitation and hygiene facilities, and medical wastage disposal

Water, sanitation, and hygiene services in healthcare facilities are essential to ensure quality health care and to facilitate infection, prevention, and control practices. Therefore, RDP in partnership with UNICEF has successfully assessed the full extent of the damage, water supplies, sanitation and hygiene facilities and medical wastage disposal in 186 HF's over six governorates, 76 in Dhamar, 39 in Amran, 18 in Al Bayda, 20 in Marib, 23 in Sana'a and 10 in Sana'a city. Some of these health facilities showed greater damages and need to be rehabilitated; otherwise, they can spread diseases instead of preventing them.



## Holding an induction workshop to discuss briefly about the new WaSH response project which is targeting 25,266 individuals of IDPs and most affected population in Hajjah & Ibb governorates

In response to the water needs which IDPs and most affected population suffer from throughout their daily life, RDP will ensure that safe and clean drinking water is easily accessible to those in need. Within the activities of WaSH response project funded by YHF, RDP WASH team conducted the induction workshop to discuss its main activities and work plans with the project team. The project will improve access to safe water, proper sanitation facilities and hygiene practices for 25,266 individuals of IDPs and vulnerable host community in Masrooh sub-district, Khayran Al Muharaq district of Hajjah governorate and Bani Saif As Safil and Bani Mubariz Sub-districts in Al Qafr district of Ibb governorate.
