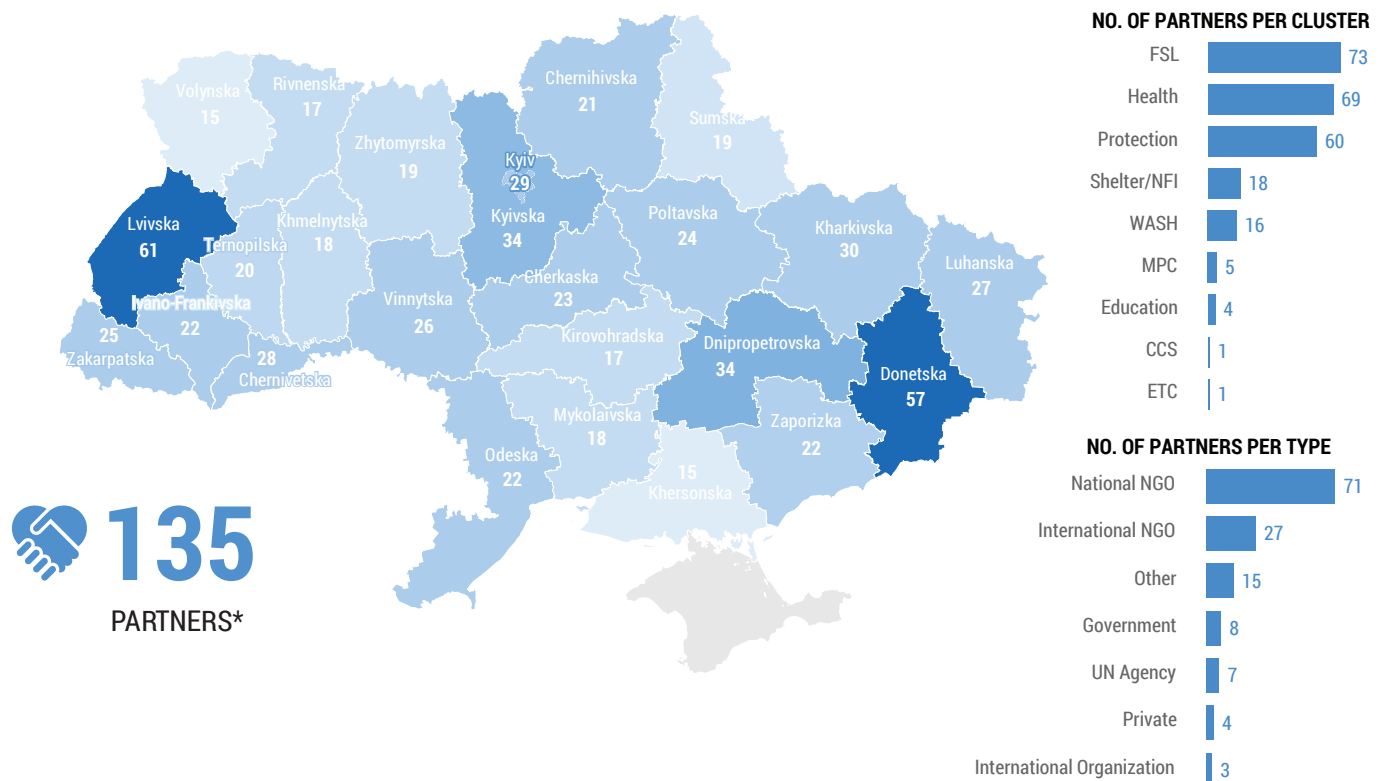

PARTNERS REACH

The United Nations and the IASC work through a wide range of humanitarian partners, including national and international organizations to provide assistance. This includes local procurement of relief items, provision of services, including medical support and protection and other key humanitarian functions. These activities are funded through the United Nations Agencies, the Ukraine Humanitarian Fund and other mechanisms. Currently, there are at least 135 humanitarian agencies completed or implementing activities in every Oblast in Ukraine in all sectoral areas. *More detailed information on agencies and activities will be published weekly through the Who-What-Where (3W) tool.*
