# **GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE**



Climate change creates and exacerbates circumstances conducive to gender-based violence. Climate action must tackle gender-based violence.



## IMPACT OF CLIMATE CHANGE ON GBV

When women and girls need to travel greater distances to gather **BASIC NECESSITIES SUCH AS WATER AND FIREWOOD** they can also be at increased risk of physical and sexual violence

#### THE TANNA WOMEN'S COUNSELLING CENTRE reported a 300% INCREASE

in new domestic violence cases after two tropical cyclones hit Tafe province in **VANUATU** in 2011 (CARE, 2015) GBV, trafficking, and child, early and forced marriages INCREASE FOLL DISASTERS AND



INCREASE FOLLOWING DISASTERS AND EXTREME WEATHER EVENTS

(McLeod, 2019; Mason, 2016)

#### During a period of drought in UGANDA from 2014 to 2018,

there was an increase in the rates of domestic violence, sexual abuse, and female genital mutilation (Mason, 2019)

#### WOMEN WHO ARE ENVIRONMENTAL DEFENDERS have also

been assaulted and killed while defending environmental commons



### Climate change INCREASES THE RISK OF VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN

(UNFCCC, 2019, etc)



WE NEED TO respond to climate impacts by strengthening health

**SYSTEMS**, including sexual and reproductive health services, and strengthening protection services in GBV responses. Climate adaptation, resilience-building policies and financing must support action to end GBV and harmful practices
