

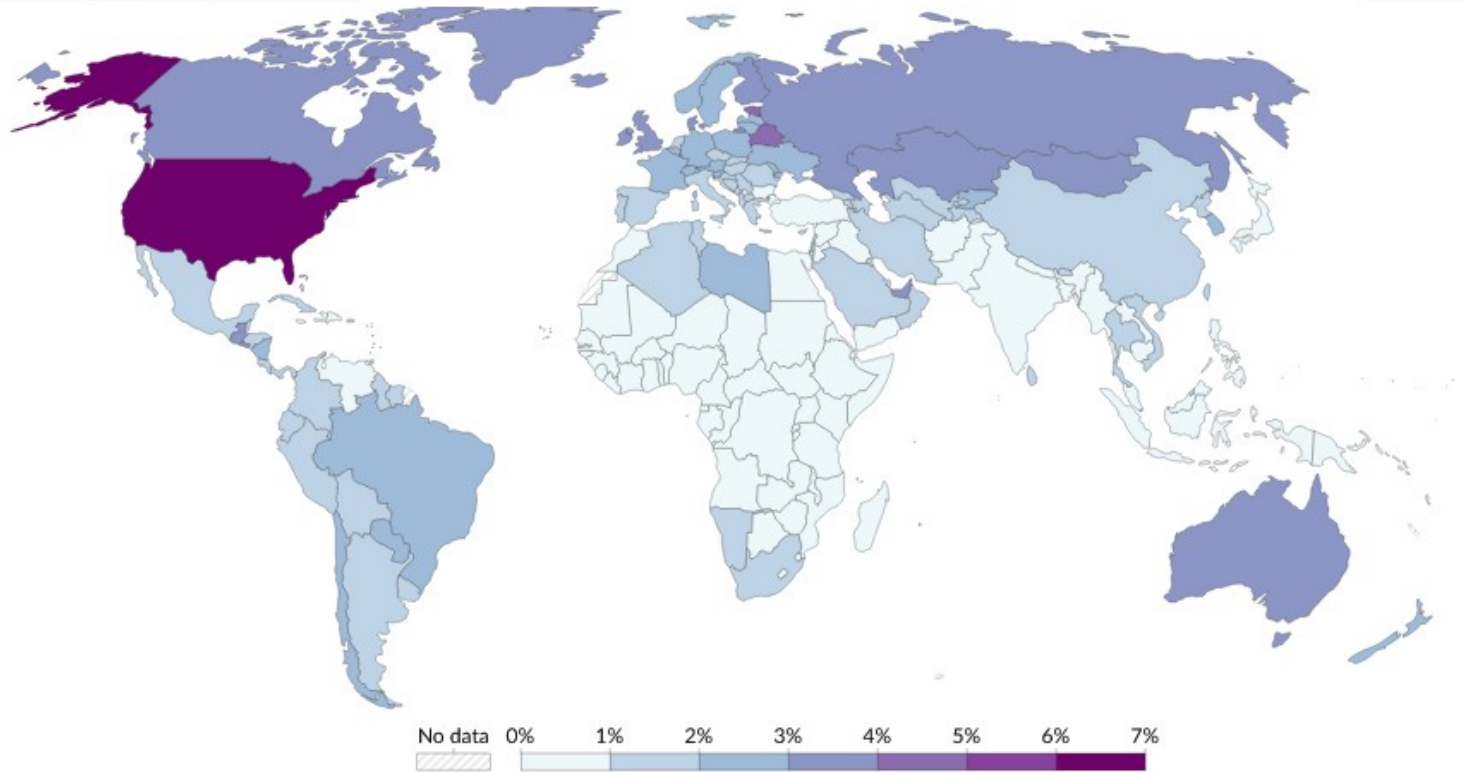
Alcohol and drug use disorders as a share of total disease burden, 2019

Our World in Data

Disease burden is measured in Disability-Adjusted Life Years (DALYs) – both from years of life lost due to premature death and years lived with a disability. One DALY equals one year of healthy life.
