## WHAT IS THE NATIONAL ASTHMA EDUCATION PROGRAMME?

The National Asthma Education Programme (or NAEP for short) was started in 2008. We are a registered Non-Profit Organisation that aims to disseminate impartial information about asthma diagnosis and treatment to health professionals and the South African public.

We work alongside other international organisations to create and disseminate asthma information. We subscribe to management guidelines set out by GINA (Global Initiative for Asthma), SATS (South African Thoracic Society) and ALLSA (Allergy Society of Asthma).

Our objectives are three fold:

- To raise awareness among patients, health professionals, and the public, that asthma is a serious chronic disease.
- To ensure that symptoms of asthma are recognised by patients, families, and the public. And that the appropriate diagnosis is made by health professionals.
- To ensure effective control of asthma by encouraging a partnership among patients, physicians, and other health professionals using appropriate, modern treatment and education programmes.

In order to accomplish these objectives, we have a number of projects running throughout the year:

- Our **6-month distance learning course** for medical professionals (more information can be found in this pamphlet).
- CME events for health care workers.
- Our **leaflets** which are available for medical professionals and the public via our website.

These include:

- Allergy and asthma
- Asthma and pregnancy
- Asthma medicines and how they work
- Keeping asthma under control
- Lung function tests
- Risk factors for asthma
- Sports and asthma
- **Newsletters** to our professional and public members.
- A media campaign leading up to World Asthma Day which is the first Tuesday in May. We take advantage of this with press releases to media outlets, as well as a social media campaign.
