





## **Key Highlights**

- 112 days since the start of the outbreak
- Males 57% are more affected
- Youths (19-29) years are the most hit 37%
- The Greater Kampala Metropolitan Area accounts for majority of the cases 62%
- The districts reporting new cases are; Kampala (15), Mbarara (03), Waksio (01), Mubende (01)
