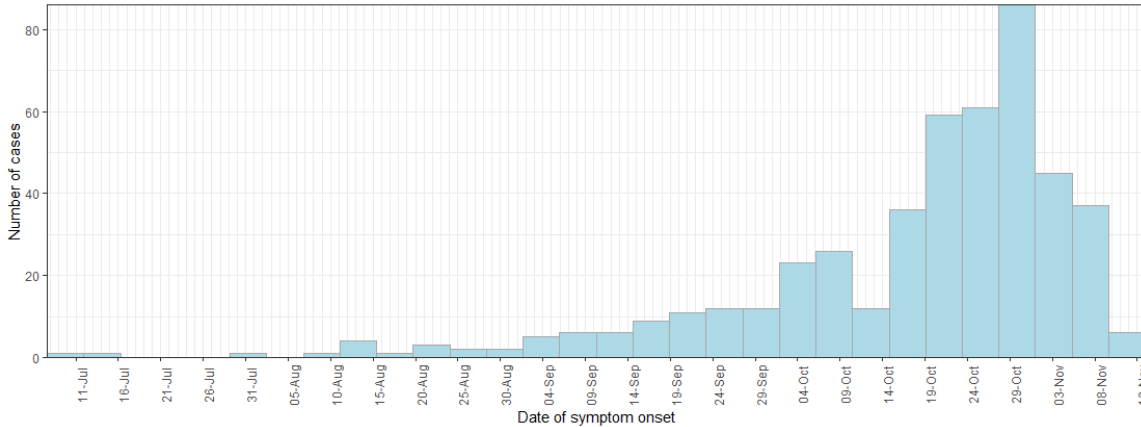

Time analysis of cases (n = 468)



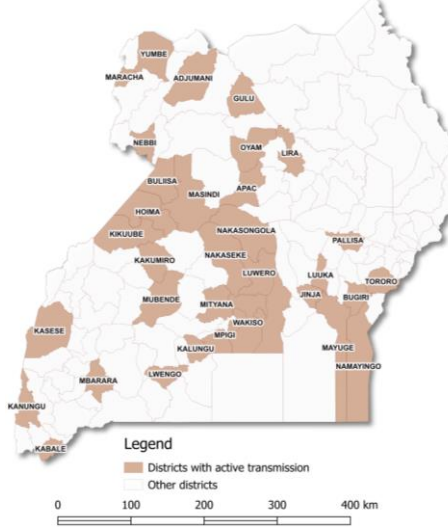
Key Highlights

- **112** days since the start of the outbreak
- Males **57%** are more affected
- Youths (19-29) years are the most hit **37%**
- The Greater Kampala Metropolitan Area accounts for majority of the cases **62%**
- The districts reporting new cases are; Kampala (**15**), Mbarara (**03**), Wakisio (**01**), Mubende (**01**)

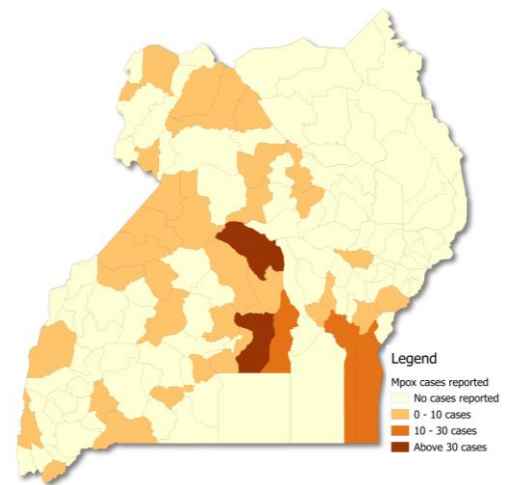
Affected districts **(38)**

Major activities

1. Weekly Incident management team coordination meeting (every Tuesday)
2. Partner engagement meeting (every Thursday)
3. Home-based Care guidelines for Mpox have been drafted
4. An Atlas of Mpox lesions in Uganda
5. Mpox case management interim guidelines have been finalised
6. Supplies for Mpox response have been prepositioned at Regional Referral Hospitals
7. Ambulance system has been functionalised to support evacuation of patients and suspects
