


OVERVIEW

In July 2025, WASH partners responded to rising humanitarian needs driven by worsening drought conditions in parts of Puntland and Somaliland, as well as escalating conflict and displacement in Gedo and Hiraan regions. Emergency water supply interventions reached 115,644 people, including 19,659 men, 20,816 women, 40,475 boys, and 34,693 girls, through water trucking and distribution of water treatment supplies. In parallel, 86,909 people accessed sustainable water supply solutions—such as rehabilitated boreholes and solar-powered systems—benefiting 14,775 men, 15,644 women, 30,418 boys, and 26,073 girls, especially in communities facing chronic water shortages.

In response to increased displacement and poor sanitation conditions in IDP settlements, 25,931 people were supported with emergency sanitation services, including 4,408 men, 4,668 women, 9,076 boys, and 7,779 girls. Additionally, hygiene promotion activities and hygiene kit distributions reached 257,683 people, comprising 43,806 men, 46,383 women, 90,189 boys, and 77,305 girls, helping to reduce public health risks in overcrowded and underserved areas. WASH partners continue to scale up life-saving interventions in coordination with other clusters to address growing needs across drought- and conflict-affected regions.




