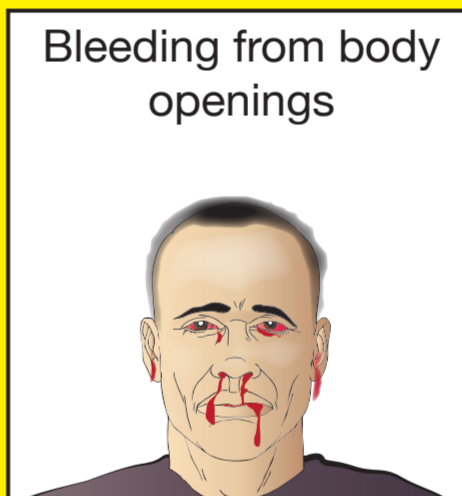
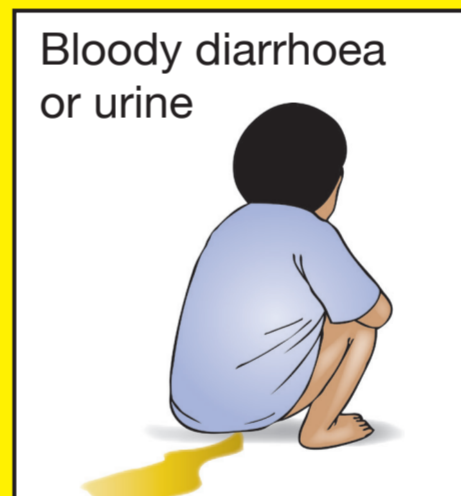
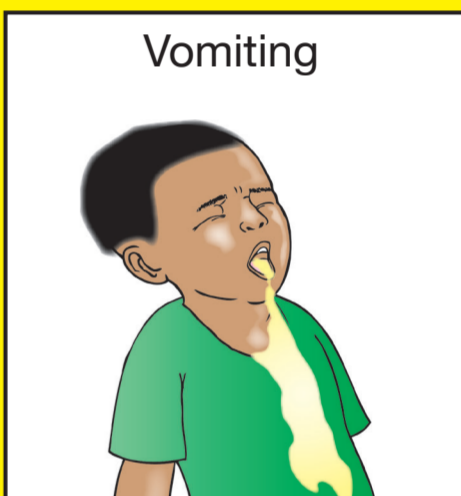
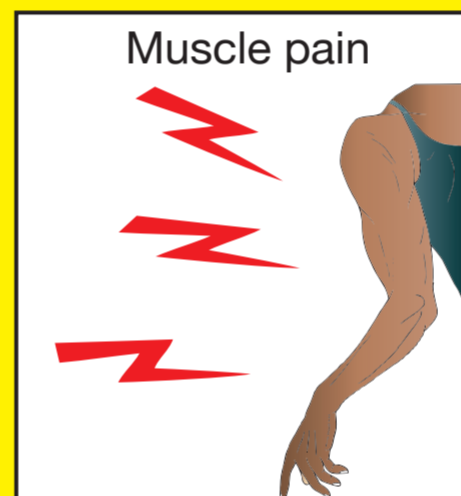
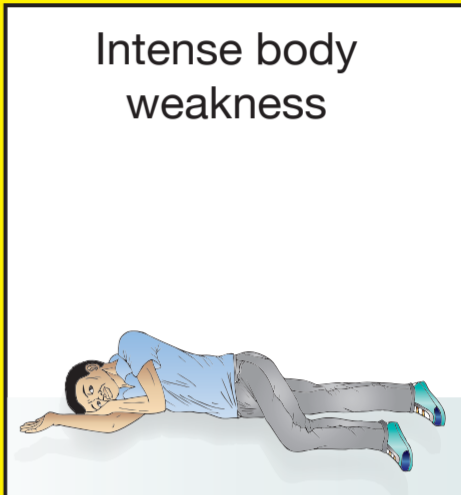
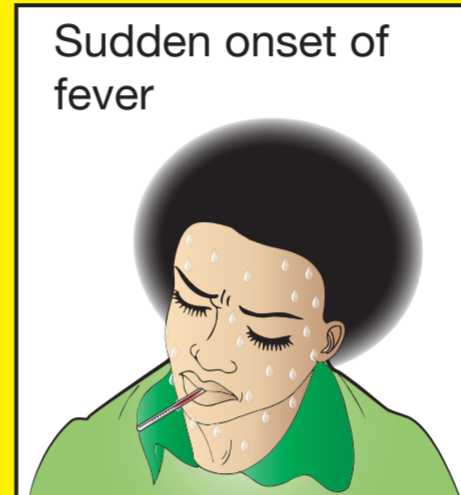
SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF EBOLA

Ebola is spread through direct contact with the following:



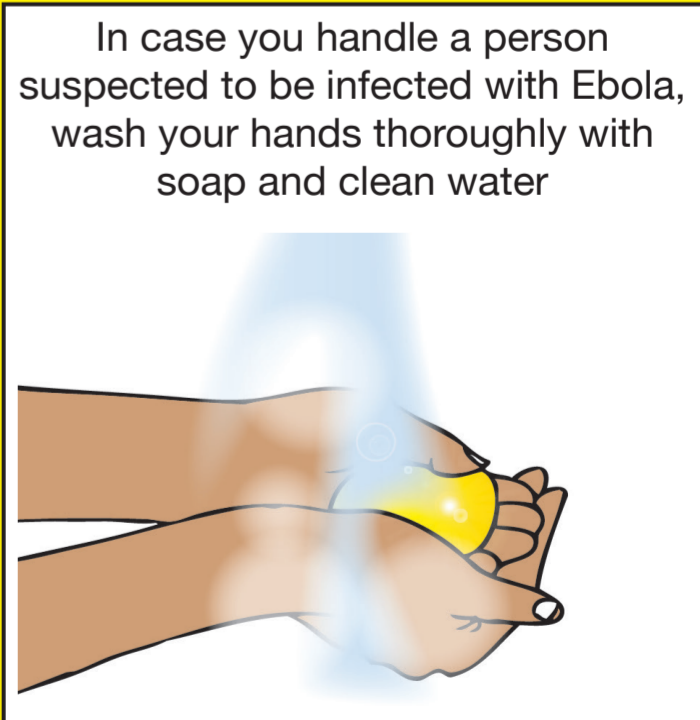
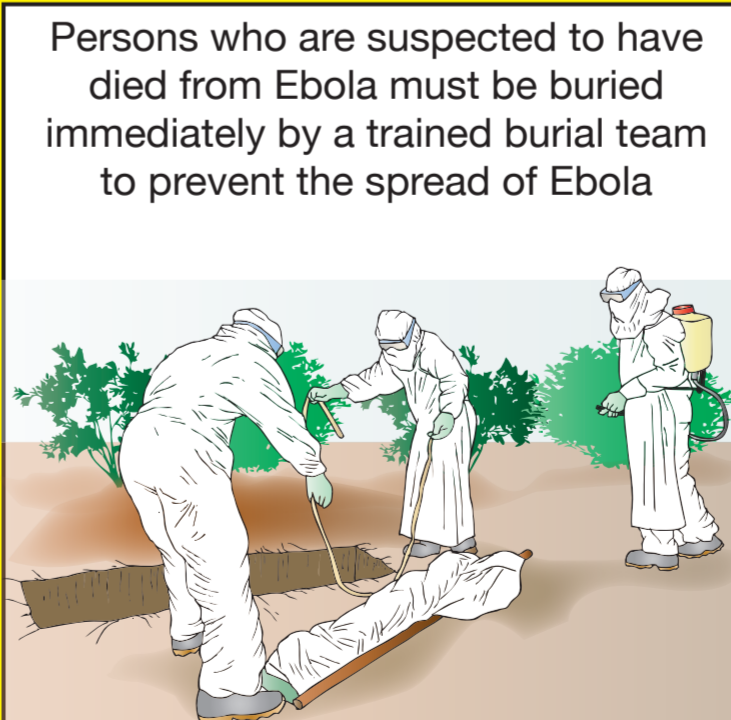
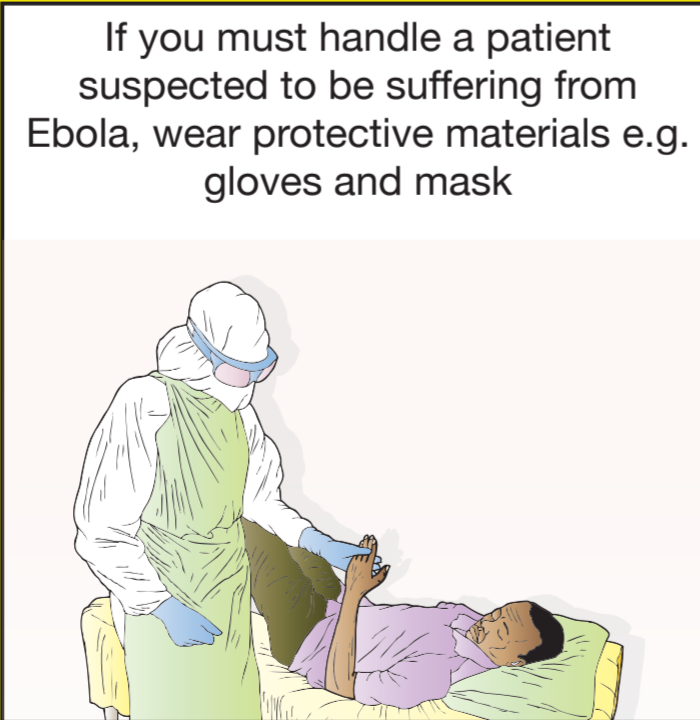
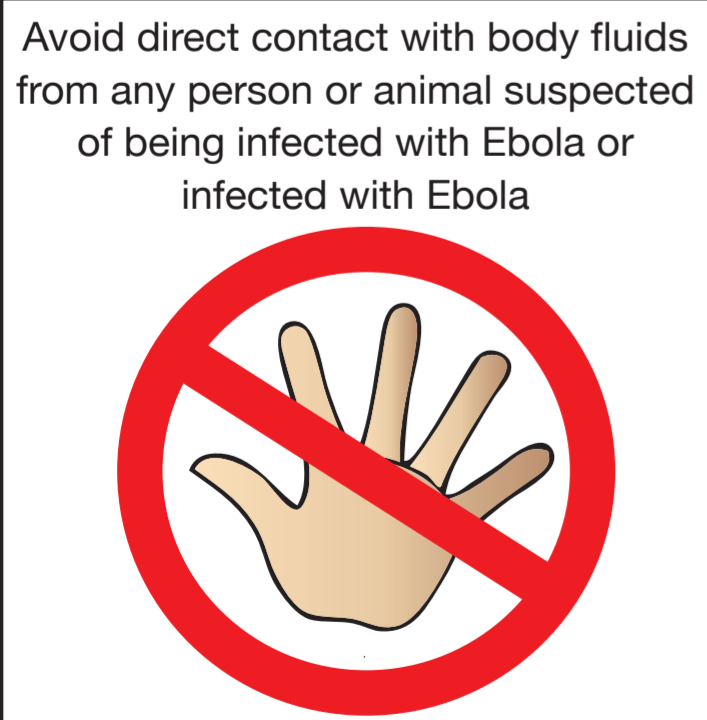
Signs and symptoms of Ebola are as follows:
